DIVISION 2: SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT (TINIAN, ETC.)

§ 2555. Commission May Grant or Refuse to Grant Application.

(a) The Commission, after giving consideration to the recommendation of the Executive Director and to such other submitted and investigatory material as it thinks fit including, as an applicable case, additional information or material referred to in the proviso to 10 CMC § 2554(a), may in its absolute discretion grant the application for a casino key employee license or a casino employee license or refuse it.

(b) The applicant shall be notified in writing in the prescribed form by the Executive Director of the decision of the Commission.

(c) The decision of the Commission is final and conclusive.

(d) The Commission may subject the grant of a license to such terms, conditions and restrictions as are considered by it to be necessary in the public interest, and may issue regulation concerning the conditions under which such a license may be granted, revoked or suspended and what fees, if any, shall be paid for such license.

(e) The provisions of 10 CMC § 25146(d) shall be applicable to this Section.
